Spring Luncheon, 2011:

Program by Co-Head Coaches A Huge Success

If you were not at the UTRA luncheon on April 14th, you missed one of the best programs, EVER! **The Day** was sunny and bright. **The Place** was Calhoun's On The River, with beautiful outside scenery of flowers, bright tree foliage, and a shimmering river. **The Food**, a bounty of pulled pork, roasted chicken, coleslaw, potato salad, baked beans, rolls/muffins, dessert, and an assortment of beverages. And then **The Program** began.

Nearly 40 UT retirees were thrilled to listen to husband and wife, Co-Head Coaches of the Lady Vols Softball team, Ralph and Karen Weekly. Both coaches gave insights as to how they came to be coaches, as well as describing the various attributes of players on the team. The top priorities that Karen and Ralph have for the team are: "Faith, Family, and Academics." Everyone agreed that abiding with those priorities would lead to nothing less than a winning team, regardless of how an individual game's score might end.

A DVD was shown of past games and Women's College World Series events. The Weekly's have led UT to four top-three finishes in that series since 2005. Coming to UT Knoxville from UT Chattanooga in 2001, and thus beginning their 10th season in Knoxville, their teams thus far have a combined record of 500-156-2 (.750). By the way, Coach Karen has just achieved her 700th career win, while Coach Ralph has recently notched his 1,000th career win. Wow, what a set of records! UT is truly fortunate to have this couple as coaches of our Lady Vols Softball team.

A post note: Following their presentation, Co-Coaches Karen and Ralph flew out of Knoxville that same afternoon with their team to LSU for a 3-game series. They won each game, and are currently in first place (Eastern Division), tied with Alabama (Western Division).

Coach Karen got her 700th career win on February 25, when the Lady Vols beat BYU, 4-1. She has coached for 15 years, after graduating from Pacific Lutheran in 1986.

Coach Ralph, a graduate of Arizona State University in 1973, achieved his 1000th career win in 2011. He was inducted into the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Hall of Fame at the end of the 2011 season.

Professor Bass, internationally recognized forensic anthropologist, came to UT in 1971 to head the Department of Anthropology. He founded the Forensic Anthropology Center, known to most as "The Body Farm." Bill is the recipient of many honors, including National Professor of the Year. Bill has over 200 scholarly publications, and more recently, he has co-authored several novels under the

pseudonym of Jefferson Bass.

Fall Color Tour via Cherohala Skyway October 20, Thursday from 8 am – 4 pm

The cost for this field trip is only **\$30 per person**, which includes transportation, meal and all gratuities. We will be departing from the UT Visitor Center at **8:00 am sharp** and will return at approximately 4:00 pm.

The trip will be via the **Cherohala Skyway** to Joyce Kilmer Memorial Forest and then on to historic Tapoca Lodge for a tasty lunch. We will have colorful people and hopefully see colorful foliage and landscapes. The Cherohala (Cherokee/Nantahala National Forests) Skyway is a two-lane highway extending approximately 50 miles between Tellico Plains, TN and Robbinsville, NC. Its construction spanned a period of nearly 30 years and cost approximately \$100 million dollars. The highway is recognized as one of the twenty or so "**National Scenic Byways.**"

The **Joyce Kilmer Memorial Forest** has a trail that leads to a cove containing giant poplar trees and very large hemlock trees. The trail is a relatively easy walk. There are two loops. The lower loop, leading to a rock memorial marking the beginning of the big trees, is about 1.2 miles long. From the memorial, a second loop (~0.8 mi.) leads to the largest of the poplar trees. There will be ample time to sample both loops or to relax while others hike.

Tapoca Lodge was constructed by the Aluminum Company of America (ALCOA) in 1930 as part of their hydroelectric efforts in Graham and Swain Counties, NC. The Lodge operated for several decades for the benefit of company employees. In 1995 the Lodge was re-opened by the Cody family of Robbinsville as a resort/retreat for the public. We will be served a fine lunch at the Lodge, then it's on to Knoxville via the famous "**Tail of the**

woody plants, both shrubs and trees, it is a rich resource for everyone to enjoy throughout the year. One can quickly determine what species and varieties do well in our area, and would also do well in your own comparable locale.

The University of Tennessee obtained the property in 1964 from land declared surplus by the former Atomic Energy Commission. In the ensuing nearly 50 years of management, this "outdoor laboratory" for research and education has produced hundreds of scientific research articles, hosted tens of thousands of grade school class visits, and welcomed the public to hike on over seven miles of trails that are posted with helpful information as to what can be seen while walking.
