

Indian Grave Point Caving

Indian grave point cave is a horizontal saltpepper wet cave located outside of Dowelltown, in Dekalb County, Tennessee. The cave ranges to a depth of 122 feet and is 3.2 miles long; this makes it one of the largest caves by area in Tennessee and the 41st longest.

Gear List:

- *Headlamp with extra batteries
- *Extra source of light (flashlight, candle, etc.)
- *Helmet
- *Day Pack

Personal Equipment

- 1 qt. water bottle
- Long, Durable Pants that can get muddy
- Long Sleeve shirt that can get muddy
- 1 warm upper layer (fleece jacket, sweater)
- Extra jacket or warm layer (can keep in backpack)
- Socks – warm enough to keep wet feet from chilling

*Available From UTOP

- Shoes to get muddy and wet. These need to cover the entire foot (no sandals). Boots or some sturdy shoe is a good choice
- Towel
- A change of clothes (cave clothes will be muddy). Don't forget clean shoes and socks
- Plastic trash bag to carry dirty clothes back.
- *Rain Jacket (if weather goes south)
- Lunch & Snacks

Optional

- Waterproof Camera
- Knee & elbow pads
- *Gloves that can get dirty
