This is a three day canoe trip with two nights of camping on the river. From the put-in on Hwy 127 near Clarkrange there are 21 miles of uninterrupted forest until the next bridge. No houses, no road, no people; just wilderness, clear water, wildlife, and some incredible scenery. Rightfully so, the run is designated as a Nation Wild and Scenic river. It is best known for its rockhouses. For one short section, the entire creek cuts under a deep over hanging ledge. Expect to see turkey, deer, beaver, and the occasional river otter.

The whitewater on this trip is rated as class II/III with one class III+ on the last day. There will be places that require portaging due to log jams, rock jumbles and downed trees in the river. With boats full of camping gear this will be physically demanding, so PACK LIGHT! Don't bring anything you wouldn't take on a backpacking trip. Leave the lounge chairs, canned goods, hound dogs and beer coolers at home.

Proper preparation for this trip is critical. Each person will be responsible for carrying their own gear in their own boat and for bringing the necessary food, clothing and camping gear for a three day trip. You and your gear will get wet. This is not a big deal as long as you're prepared. I'll do a demo on how to pack and what to bring at the April 9th meeting. Plan on spending 3 or more hours packing the night before the trip. A suggested packing list is on the back of this sheet.
