The editors and review board are undergraduate students who review submissions and work with select faculty and staff to publish *Pursuit*.

Pursuit is currently accepting submissions for the Spring 2015 edition (Volume 6, Issue 1). Submissions must have been written during the author's undergraduate studies, though authors may submit work to *Pursuit* up to one year after graduating.

The priority deadline for submissions is October 23, 2014. The final deadline for submissions is January 6, 2015.

Humanities and Social Science papers may be up to 30 pages maximum; Science and Engineering papers may be up to 15 pages maximum. Endnotes must be used instead of footnotes. Please include a short biography of yourself.
