

GRADUATE RESEARCH ASSISTANTSHIPS IN Sustainability / Geographic Information Science / Urban Planning & Development

The Center for Sustainability—a graduate-degree-granting institute at Saint Louis University—is seeking applications for the following graduate-level research assistantships:

- **Sustainability or Geographic Information Science (with a focus on research)**
- **Sustainability (with a focus on facilities management)**
- **Urban planning and development (with a focus on research)**

Graduate research assistantships are competitive and based on a candidate's academic record and relevant experience rather than financial need. Assistantships are for two years and include tuition scholarships of 9 credit hours per semester during the 9-month academic year (18 hours total per year), a monthly stipend of \$16,000 per year and health insurance. Research assistants work 20 hours per week for the university and may not have outside employment.

Candidates interested in a graduate assistantship must complete the online application for admission to either the M.S. in Sustainability / Geographic Information Science / Urban Planning and Development programs by December 31, 2015.
