## Assistant Professor of Environmental Studies - Fall 2016

The teaching load includes 2-3 courses each semester and a 4-week January focused-study Interim term.

A principal responsibility of this position will be to help lead a significant new sustainability initiative at the college. The successful candidate will use quantitative expertise to help analyze and improve the sustainability of campus operations (e.g. energy, food systems, waste streams, landscape evolution). Demonstrated ability to engage students in those activities will be a distinct advantage in the selection process.
