Maroon 5 Concert September 14, 2016

Expected attendance: approx. 14,000

Parking restrictions: 4:00pm is when the lots surrounding the Arena will be converted to concert parking

Primary parking for concert attendees:
G10, G5/30, G4, G3, G16

Wednesday night classes: Parking available in Staff 9, White Ave and 11th Street garages

Clear bag policy in place (like Neyland)

Construction on Volunteer Blvd

- ◆ Construction continues on Volunteer Blvd with an anticipated ending of October (not including plantings)
- ◆ TREC's entrance on Volunteer Blvd is scheduled to open later in September after the ADA accessible entrance and the sidewalk construction on the north side are completed
- ◆ New stairway from Volunteer Blvd up the hill to TREC's will also open in mid-September. Wooden handrails will be installed while the permanent handrails are fabricated.
- ◆ Plantings will occur in November and December

Construction on Cumberland Ave

- ◆ From Sept 6-15 construction crews will remove of pre-WW II trolley lines in center of road from 19th to 22nd
- ◆ Construction will take place 24 hrs a day to accomplish the work before the next home game
- ◆ Westbound lanes of Cumberland have shifted to the north side of the street
- ◆ Nighttime detours will occur between 19th and 22nd



Reminder there is **NO** parking on sidewalks. Please remind your vendors they will be ticketed.

T Bus Ridership is up

- ◆ Ridership on the T bus system for campus had an increase of 58,000 riders last year, a 6% increase over previous years
- ◆ Late Nite - Primary way to get around campus from 6pm to 2:30 am
- ◆ On-Demand Link service—operate 6 pm—7 am (here is your safety net for any very late nights or very early morning transportation needs)
- ◆ Continuing shuttle services for JIAM and ORNL/PSCC



Results of August 22-25 parking counts

- ◆ We are very busy—Monday—Thursday from 9 am to 2 pm in all garages
- ◆ New G16 garage on Volunteer Blvd is filling early and staying busy—we are getting multiple uses from each parking space during the day
- ◆ Students with later morning or early afternoon classes should consider surface lots—specifically C22, C11, & C7
- ◆ Gravel lot next to Lake Ave garage has S12 and Commuter parking until construction begins
