We expect the development of joint grant proposals, projects and publications and co-supervision of PhD students.

- Strong quantitative skills, e.g. advanced statistical analysis or ecological modelling
- Previous postdoctoral experience is preferred, but not mandatory

- Excellent oral and written communication skills as well as networking skills
