EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

In a field environment, assist with general forest management to include: marking timber, marking boundaries, establishing/monitoring Streamside Management Zones and stump cruises. Assist with aerial surveys (conducted from an airplane) to diagnose potential insect and disease infestations. Assist with timber cruising and setting up timber sales on State land. May operate trucks and various heavy equipment in execution of duties. Field work will require extended work outdoors. Applicants should expect extremely hot and humid conditions as well as exposure to insects/wildlife common to Georgia.

In an office environment, conduct thorough searches of available property and forestry records. Prepare reports, including measuring and computing acreage.
