The Office of Research and Development at the EPA supports research to improve the scientific basis for decisions on national environmental issues and help EPA achieve its environmental goals. Research is conducted in a broad range of environmental areas by scientists in EPA laboratories and at universities across the country.

The candidate shall work with a mentor as part of a multi-disciplinary research team and provide technical support for development of watershed modeling components. The work shall include development, testing, deployment, and documenting of desktop and web software as part of the component/service based watershed hydrology within the context of water quantity and water quality.

Location: This job will be located at EPA's facility in Athens, GA.

Salary: The selected applicant will become a full time temporary employee of ORAU and will receive an hourly wage of \$20.04 for hours worked.

Expected Start Date: The position start date is February 2017. The selected applicant will be temporary employees of ORAU working as a contractor to EPA. The initial contract period is through May 14, 2017. EPA may elect to renew the contract for an additional three 12-month optional periods.
