A demonstrated ability to work within the framework of NEPA, the Endangered Species Act, the Clean Water Act, and state executive orders pertaining to Greater Sage-grouse is required. Competitive applicants will have strong technical writing skills, statistical knowledge, and a desire to contribute to business development. Experience with data management, ecological risk assessment, and GIS/CADD applications is preferred. Prior experience with ecological projects and environmental regulations in the western U.S. is required.
