Subject: EE organization is hiring a Yellowstone summer program supervisor in Missoula, MT

Ecology Project International's Yellowstone Program is seeking an energetic operations and education guru to act as our new Yellowstone summer program supervisor to oversee the delivery of courses that reach over 200 local and visiting middle and high school students each summer. Our environmental education program is unique in the opportunities we provide students to interact directly with wildlife biologists and collect data for impactful ongoing wildlife and natural resource studies happening in the world's first national park - Yellowstone. We have a robust program evaluation system in place that allows us to track how we impact our student's knowledge, dispositions, competencies, and behaviors, and allows us to identify areas for improvement in our programming. Our Yellowstone summer program supervisor will supervise nine high performing field educators and coordinate our program's relationships with the Yellowstone National Park bison, botany, and bear management teams. The position is approximately 95% office-based and 5% field-based. This is a full-time (40 hours/week), permanent position based in Missoula.
