United States Marine Jonathan Toney has been named the recipient of the Matthew Christian Scholarship for the 2017-18 academic year.

Toney currently serves in Marine Corp Delta Company, Fourth Combat Engineer Battalion as a combat engineer. He is a construction science major, with a minor in business administration. Toney looks to graduate in the Spring of 2019.

The Matthew Christian Scholarship was created in honor of former Marine Matthew Keith Christian, who was killed by a drunk driver on July 6, 1987 at the age of 22.

He is remembered as very quiet, but curious, energetic, and full of wonder. Additionally, he is described as someone who always gave more of himself than was required.

Christian was a member of UT's Pride of the Southland Band, playing trumpet, and was a member of the Pi Kappa Phi fraternity.

Criteria for obtaining the scholarship focuses on those who are admitted or enrolled at The University of Tennessee, Knoxville. Preference in the selection includes students who are members of the Marine Corps Reserve or who participate in the Marine ROTC program, and who demonstrate successful academic performance and/or financial need.
