This is a fulltime position in our Louisville office. Responsibilities of the Forester/Forest Ecologist will be to manage, supervise, and research forestry practices related to: reforestation of disturbed lands, implementation of best planting practices, forest community classification/assessment, invasive/exotic species control, timber stand improvement, targeted wildlife habitat restoration, fire science, pest infestation assessment and treatments (HWA/EAB), urban forestry practices and canopy modeling, agroforestry, GIS mapping, and other related disciplines.

SAF and ISA certifications, applicable pesticide applicators licenses, and/or NRCS TSP practice certifications are encouraged but not necessary. Working knowledge of forestry, agriculture, propagation, and arboriculture implements are additionally encouraged.

Several positions in our Louisville office will be available, including permanent/fulltime and seasonal/part-time durations. Responsibilities of the Restoration Technician will be to implement field restoration practices related to: reforestation of disturbed lands, installation of native grassland and savannah habitats, invasive/exotic species control, timber stand improvement, targeted wildlife habitat restoration, fire science, pest infestation treatments (HWA/EAB), and other related disciplines.

This position will require an understanding and the willingness to learn of the safe and proper use of restoration equipment, vegetation chemical/physical control treatments, and agriculture-type equipment and implements. Pesticide applicators licenses are encouraged but not necessary. The successful applicant will be expected to follow direction from team leaders and other professional staff, operate habitat restoration equipment and implements, maintain professional appearance and demeanor, conduct themselves safely in the presence of heavy equipment and hand tools, show initiative to learn, and conduct inspections and regular maintenance on a variety of company-owned mechanical equipment. Opportunities will exist to assist other professionals within our office on several biological, restoration, and engineering field study needs across the eastern U.S.
