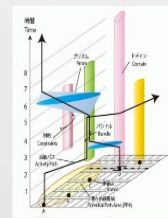

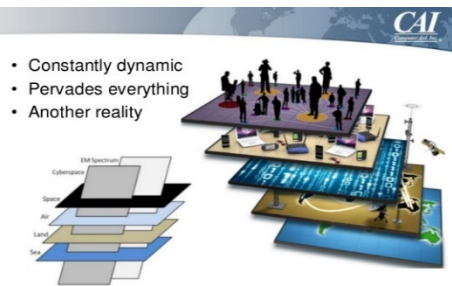


- Space and place are two critical concepts in geography.
