***Effective July 1, 2017** OUT OF STATE TUITION WAIVER for veterans & dependents

A veteran or other individual eligible to receive educational benefits administered by the United States Department of Veteran's Affairs, through any provision of federal law, may not be required to pay outof-state tuition or any out-of-state fee when the veteran or other individual is:

- (1) Enrolled in any public institution of higher education in Tennessee;
- (2) Utilizing such benefits at the enrolling institution; and
- (3) Living in Tennessee, regardless of the individual's formal state of residency.

*Eligibility for VA education benefits is determined by the Department of Veteran Affairs.
