- And bring passion to your work!

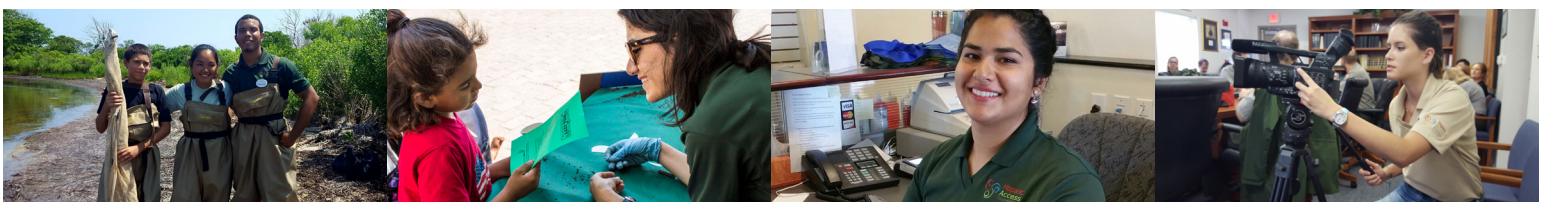
