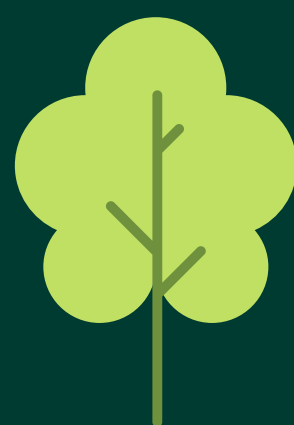
CO-PRESIDENTS CURRENTLY MAYA AND MEGAN
