

# Commission for Women (CFW) 2021-22 Awards

## **Angie Warren Perkins Award – *Nominations Due January 10, 2022***

Named after the first Dean of Women at UTK, this award honors a woman at entry-level status within their department (first 5 years of teaching/research career) for her excellence in teaching and scholarship.

**Qualifications:** Regular full or part-time employee, minimum of 1-year continuous service at UTK, have not received the award in the past 5 years. Information about the award and a list of recent award winners are available on the Chancellor's Honors website.

**What should be Included in the Nomination:** Name of the Nominee, Nominee's Responsible Department, Nominee's Position Title, Nominee's Appointment Date, and the Nominating Statement as well as the Nominator's Name, department, e-mail address, and phone number. **How to Nominate:** Send nomination letters and candidates current CV or resume electronically to Jill Zambito (CFW awards committee co-chair) at [zambito@utk.edu](mailto:zambito@utk.edu)

## **Rising UT Woman Award – *Nominations Due January 10, 2022***

Recognizes a woman in early stages of her professional path who has made great strides in her area and shows exceptional future promise. On a rotating basis, the award recognizes undergraduates, early career staff, graduate students, and early career faculty.

**Qualifications:** For the 2022 award, early career staff members (exempt & non-exempt, below the level of Director) and graduate students will be recognized. Attributes of candidates include: outstanding in area/field of study, made significant impacts on UTK or broader community, and has great promise for future impact.

**What should be Included in the Nomination:** The name of the nominator, department or academic program, e-mail address, and phone number. ## **Notable UT Woman Award – *Nominations Due January 10, 2022***

The Commission for Women recognized its first Notable UT Woman in 1995 after a suggestion from University Historian Dr. Milton Klein, who recommended that outstanding women connected with the University of Tennessee be honored annually. This award honors outstanding women connected to UTK from four rotating categories: administrator, alumnae, faculty, and staff. This year the Commission will recognize **a UTK faculty member**.

**Qualifications:** UTK faculty member who is: outstanding in her field, a pioneer/groundbreaker, conducted/contributed/supported gender-related research or research that benefits women and/or facilitated the implementation of research for women, has rendered program support and development beneficial to UTK, and/or has improved the lives of women in the community.
