The Rotary District 6780 Education Committee is seeking candidates for the Rotary Global Scholar Grant for study abroad in 2022-2023. District funds are currently committed for one scholar. The minimum award is \$30,000 but may be higher. District 6780 makes every effort to fund the entire cost of the academic year abroad.

- Applicant must have completed an undergraduate degree
- Applicant may not be a Rotarian, lineal descendent (child or grandchild), or Rotary employee
- Must be to study in one of seven areas of focus
- Only a current Grant Qualified Rotary Club in D 6780 may sponsor the scholar candidate
- Scholarship application must be accompanied by letter of acceptance from school of choice
- Scholar must have a sponsor counselor and Host Sponsor Counselor
- Candidates will be interviewed by the District Selection Committee
- Application for funding grant must be accompanied by the sponsor Rotary clubs' letter of recommendation
- Scholar must:
 - Begin study within 6 months of notification of grant award,
 - Live in the immediate vicinity of study institution,
 - Complete all required reports during and after scholarship period
- If approved, funding would be \$30,000 for one academic year
