We are happy to announce that in partnership between the Tennessee Electronic Library and ProQuest, Tennesseans now have access to the following newspapers:

THE KNOXVILLE NEWS SENTINEL is a daily newspaper founded in Knoxville, Tennessee. It covers the news in Knoxville and the surrounding area from the 1880s to today.

The *Knoxville News Sentinel* readers will find coverage on state politics and legislation, school board meetings, local businesses and culture, zoning board meetings, as well as historical events like the assassination of Martin Luther King Jr., and more.

THE COMMERCIAL APPEAL is a daily newspaper founded in Memphis, Tennessee. It covers the news in Memphis and the surrounding area from the 1840s to today.

The *Commercial Appeal* is most widely known for its coverage of civil rights issues, including coverage of segregation, the Memphis sanitation strike, and the assassination of Martin Luther King Jr.
