- 2. If you are a Wilson County resident, you must enter in the Wilson County Fruits & Vegetable Competition in the same Class and Lot prior to entering the state competition. (See page 36)
- 3. All articles are exhibited at owner's risk, but all reasonable precautions will be taken for protection of items. Deteriorated items will be discarded as required.
- 4. Prizes will be awarded on the decision of the judge.
- 5. Vegetables will be judged on quality (uniform in size, fresh, firm and undamaged; free of disease and insects.) If only one entry in class, it will not automatically win first place.
- 6. NO REFRIGERATED OR FROZEN ITEMS WILL BE ACCEPTED
- 7. One entry per person in each lot.
- 8. All vegetables and fruits must be grown in the 2023 season.
- 9. All exhibits must be grown on home farm in the State of Tennessee.
- 10. Premiums will be paid and exhibits removed on Sunday, August 27, from 1:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m. Entries left after 3:00 p.m. will be discarded.
