What we Offer

- Financial support for the pursuit of an undergraduate degree for up to two years and two additional years for students choosing to pursue a Master's degree
- Two paid summer internships under the guidance of an accomplished mentor
- Opportunities to engage with the EM community and other STARS participants
- Academic and career guidance
- Potential employment upon completion of program

Financial Support Includes:

- Tuition
- Stipend during the academic year
- Education Allowance
- Stipend and Travel Allowance for two summer internships

ELIGIBILITY

- Be a U.S. citizen at the time of application.
- Be 18 years of age by June 1, 2024.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.
- Be enrolled as an undergraduate student at an accredited Minority Serving Institution (MSI) during the 2023-2024 academic year pursuing a STEM degree in a discipline that supports the Office of Environmental Management research and operations.
- Have completed two full years towards an undergraduate degree and planning to graduate no earlier than the end of the Spring 2025 semester/trimester.
